

What do I do when I have my items together?

- ▶ Email uslibaskets@usli.com if you have not done so already to let us know you will be donating
- Complete the online donation form by September 8, 2023
- ▶ Please do not ship your donations to USLI prior to the auction
 - We ask that you hold onto your items and keep them in their original packaging; you are responsible for shipping the items to the winner at the end of the auction
 - We encourage you to purchase your donations ahead of time to ensure that they do not go out of stock or become unavailable by the end of the auction
 - You are responsible for shipping costs

Please let us know what items you will be donating no later than September 8, 2023.

Please note: Due to unexpected donations we may receive, we may add items to your bundle. If this is the case, we will notify you of any change.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I start?

We want to help you by offering great ideas and guidelines for your donation! We recommend referencing the categories and examples on page 2. If you have a different idea in mind, please email us at uslibaskets@usli.com. Remember: Your goal is to raise money for Breastcancer.org.

Would you accept a donation?

If you would like to make a check donation to **Breastcancer.org**, or if you would like to write a check and have our team build your basket, please email **uslibaskets@usli.com**. You can also make a donation on **pink.usli.com**.

How much should I spend on my bundle of items?

We ask that your entire donation be valued at \$350 or more. If you have any concerns or would like to donate something of lesser value, don't hesitate to reach out to <u>uslibaskets@usli.com</u>. Please also note that you should calculate the total value using the amount you paid for the items. For example, if you purchase a designer bag from an outlet at a discounted price, you should use that price instead of the full list price.

Why do I need a main item?

Having one item that is more expensive than the other "fillers" attracts attention in an auction. It gets bidders excited about the bundle and increases the value. Including only small items will likely attract low bids.

Can I just donate one high-priced item?

We don't recommend doing this because people will know the exact value, and it's likely no bids will come through for more than what the item is worth. To attract higher bids, we recommend adding other smaller items to make the main item more enticing. For example, an iPad on its own might not bring in a bid for more than what it's worth. However, if you pair the iPad with a keyboard, headphones, an Apple gift card, a case and other smaller items, bidders are more likely to place higher bids.

I participated last year and noticed you held three mini auctions instead of one. Will you be doing that again this year?

Yes, we will be holding three auctions again this October and will notify you regarding which one your donation will be in. Each auction opens on a Wednesday and closes on a Friday. We choose which donations to include in each auction based on item categories (e.g., auction one might include all fitness and tech donations). We find this formula keeps bidders engaged and raises more money.

Do I need to ship my items to USLI prior to the auction?

No, you should not ship your items to USLI prior to the auction. Please hold onto your items and leave them in their original packaging. At the end of the auction, we will provide you with the winner's shipping/contact information so that you can ship the items directly to them at your own cost or email them if the item is digital.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I wait to purchase my items until the end of the auction so that I can have them shipped to the winner's address?

We do not recommend this because there is no way for you to ensure that your items will still be in stock by the end of the auction. Instead, we encourage you to purchase your items ahead of time and keep them in their original packaging.

How will my office be highlighted as a donor?

If your office donates a bundle of items, we will list your office's name and logo on our auction website in October. Think of it as free advertising for your office.

Who can bid on the donations?

Anyone can bid! We encourage all of our donors to tell their friends, families and colleagues about the auction because the general public can visit the auction website and participate in the bidding. The more people we reach, the greater the impact we're making for breast cancer awareness and education!

Will I receive a tax form for my donation?

Yes, you will receive a tax form based on the value of your donation. If your donation is valued over \$500, we will send you IRS Form 8283 via email. In order to take a tax deduction on your contribution, you will need to complete IRS Form 8283 and return it to USLI. After the auction, we will complete the remainder of the form and return it to you for your tax records.

If your donation is valued under \$500, USLI will mail you a donation receipt letter that you can use for your tax records. This letter includes our tax ID.

What is Breastcancer.org?

Breastcancer.org is a nonprofit organization that offers women and families a community environment where they can feel supported and resources that will assist with making difficult medical decisions. Additionally, **Breastcancer.org** spreads awareness and prevention through education in an effort to stop breast cancer from happening in the first place. Their goal is to inform, empower and inspire women to make better choices today to improve their health in the future.
